You may be aware that a team from the BNHS are busy preparing a new book which is due for publication in spring 2020. It is to be titled *Bedfordshire – our changing habitats and wildlife*. It will provide, through a rich photographic record, an overview of the changes that have taken place within our county to its wildlife and the habitats in which they live over the twenty years that have elapsed since we published *Wild Bedfordshire – a photographic record*. In places there will be comparative photos taken at the same location many years apart. The captions will offer further insight into the story told within the pictures. There are also many exciting images of the fauna and flora lost and gained to the county over the last twenty years.

The authors are Richard Revels FRPS, well-known photographer, who has photographed species and locations across the length and breadth of the country; Chris Boon, award winning *Flora of Bedfordshire* author; and Graham Bellamy, formerly Senior Conservation Manager in Bedfordshire for the Wildlife Trust. Rosemary Brind and Chris Boon have edited the text. There are guest chapters on the challenges and consequences of human intervention across the county in the last two decades. Richard's excellent photographs, collected during many hours of fieldwork, show the diverse range of habitats to be found throughout Bedfordshire.

The cost of *Bedfordshire - our changing habitats and wildlife* is £20 plus post and packing of £4.25, with a pre-publication offer of £15 plus post and packing of £4.25. You will receive further information about the pre-publication offer later in the year.

Richly illustrated with quality photographs supported by informative captions the book will be around 144 pages.
