Come and enjoy a family activity day run by the BNHS and hosted by Jordans Mill.

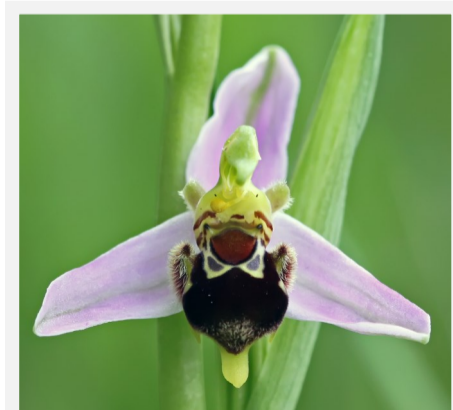
- Static displays will demonstrate the aims of the Society, show some of the activities that members enjoy.
